1. Fill out an application online for an Initial License:
www.mass.gov/ese/licensure
2. You must download and complete the verification of out-of-state program form: <http://www.doe.mass.edu/edprep/nasdtec.html> and email to Dianna Geissert, dianna.l.geissert@uconn.edu or mail to: Neag School of Education, University of Connecticut, 249 Glenbrook Road, Unit 3064, Storrs, CT 06269-3064. We will sign it and mail it back to you (MA wants original signed copy).
3. Official transcript (with verification of bachelor's degree)
