1. Complete [online application](#) for an Initial License:
2. Massachusetts requires an [SEI endorsement](#); if you do not hold SEI endorsement, you can apply for a [Temporary or Preliminary license](#).
3. You must download and complete the [verification of out-of-state program form](#) and email to Diane Matteau, diane.matteau@uconn.edu or mail to: Neag School of Education, University of Connecticut, 249 Glenbrook Road, Unit 3064, Storrs, CT 06269-3064. We will sign it and mail it back to you (MA wants original signed copy).
4. Official transcript (with verification of bachelor's degree)
